

## Open Enrollment is May 5 - May 30, 2025

Open Enrollment is here: your annual opportunity to review your benefits and make changes for the upcoming plan year (July 1, 2025-June 30, 2026).

Your plan or monthly premium may have changed!! Some Associations/Employers added new or modified existing benefit plan offerings for this upcoming year. Please verify you have selected the plan that meets your family's needs. Contact your association/employer for details. Please login to your miBenefits portal at <a href="https://www.mibenefits.ebms.com">www.mibenefits.ebms.com</a> to review or make any changes.

#### **How to make changes:**

If you are enrolled and wish to change your plan selection offered by your Association/Employer, you will need to access your mibenefits portal at <a href="www.mibenefits.ebms.com">www.mibenefits.ebms.com</a> during open enrollment to make any changes. **This process must be completed no later than 4:30 p.m.** (**AK time**) **on Friday, May 30, 2025.** The portal provides you with the list of dependents on your plan. If you are adding dependents who are not currently enrolled, you must include verification they are an eligible dependent by attaching documentation (i.e., marriage or birth certificate, etc.). Please contact either the Public Education Health Trust (PEHT) or your human resource department for options.

If you are currently waived and wish to enroll, you must contact the PEHT office for us to send you an email invite to access the mibenefits portal at <a href="www.mibenefits.ebms.com">www.mibenefits.ebms.com</a>. The email invite will provide you with access to the enrollment process. All required steps must be completed **no later than 4:30 p.m. (AK time) on Friday, May 30, 2025**.

If you are currently enrolled and wish to waive coverage; log into mibenefits at <a href="https://www.mibenefits.ebms.com">www.mibenefits.ebms.com</a> prior to and no later than 4:30 p.m. (AK time) on Friday, May 30, 2025, to waive. Please note: Some school districts require proof of other coverage to be eligible to waive from this plan. Please contact your human resources department for their criteria.

PEHT recommends that you review your dependents listed to ensure accuracy. With appropriate documentation, PEHT provides coverage for spouses, qualified domestic partners, children up to the age of 26, and individuals for whom you are the legal guardian up to the age of 18. # New Programs/Plan Changes Effective July 1, 2025:

• **HDHP Plan Adjustments:** To maintain IRS HSA compliance with the High-Deductible Health Plan (HDHP), the individual deductible for the HDHP plan will increase to \$1,650, and the family deductible will increase to \$3,300.
